Dear Parents.

We are officially in the third wave of Covid-19 in Gauteng and we all need to look after ourselves and others!

The following for your attention:

## Learner Absenteeism:

- Please do not send any sick learner to school. If your child shows any symptoms of flu, has a headache, vomiting, diarrhea etc. he/she needs to stay at home. Consult a healthcare facility.
- If a learner has come into contact with a suspected Covid-19 person he/she must stay at home until the results have been received. If positive, the learner must quarantine for 10 days. If negative, the learner can come to school.
- If a learner has been exposed to a confirmed case of Covid-19, the learner must quarantine at home for 10 days.

Please let the class teacher know of any of the above so that the necessary arrangements can be made for work/homework/assessment tasks.

## To Prevent the Spread:

- Ensure that learners do not leave home without wearing their masks, especially in the transport!
- Masks must be worn at school. NO MASK, NO ENTRY!!
- Make sure learners wash their hands with soap and water regularly at home.
- Avoid huge crowds and social distance with others where possible.
- Remember SMSV Social Distance, Mask, Sanitize, Ventilate

#### Statistics:

- Teachers and staff at school follow all Covid protocols and are also absent for normal flu etc., they isolate or are in quarantine.
- So far, we have had 3 confirmed Covid-19 staff member cases. We report to the DBE, Health Dept. and Covid Control Centre on a daily basis.

- 2 of the 3 have returned to school after their isolation. 1 is well but still isolating. 3 staff members are in quarantine after being in contact with positive cases.
- We have around 8 learners in quarantine. No learner has tested positive yet.
   We will keep you updated.
- As a school we follow all protocols on cleaning and disinfection after cases have been confirmed. All classes are cleaned, disinfected, and sanitized daily by our GA's. We also sanitize all stairs, railings, doorknobs, bathrooms every afternoon.

# Public Holiday:

 Wednesday, 16 June is a public holiday, Youth Day. There is no school. As indicated in the Term plan the **Red** group will come to school Thursday, followed by the **Yellow** group on Friday. Both groups write Mathematics Tests on those days (Gr. 4 - 7).
